

Coordination Agreement in the band 470 MHz – 790 MHz between the Administrations of France and Belgium.

This Agreement modifies the Agreement "GE06 'conditional' administrative declarations concerning band IV-V between France and Belgium", signed in Geneva on 16th of June 2006 and revised the 15th of September 2008.

This Agreement is the technical basis for the implementation of additional requirements to the Geneva 2006 Agreement in the band 470 MHz – 790 MHz between the Administrations of Belgium and France for broadcasting services. It specifies the bilaterally agreed compatibility criteria and restrictions for new and modified entries of the GE06 Plan as listed in Annex 1. The technical characteristics of the new and modified assignments are described in Annex 2. The technical characteristics of the allotments for which the shapes are new or modified are described in Annex 3.

The Administrations agree:

1. That this Agreement concerns the UHF entries of France in relation to the UHF entries of Belgium and vice-versa.
2. That this Agreement can only be revised or abrogated with the agreement of both of the above Administrations.
3. To modify, add or delete their entries in the GE06 Plan according to Annex 1 in accordance with procedures in Article 4
4. That the following abbreviations are used in the document :
 - a. ADD : Additional entry to the GE06 Plan
 - b. MOD : Modification of the registered GE06 Plan entry
 - c. SUP : Suppression of the registered GE06 Plan entry
 - d. NOC : No change to the GE06 Plan entry
5. That the conditions of field strength values have to be verified using ITU-R P 1546, 1% time, mixed path, at 10m as described in Chapters 2 and 3 of the Geneva 2006 Agreement.

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6. That for situations where the term "excluding" is not mentioned in the conditions imposed, the complete implementation of an allotment for one administration will not produce a cumulative interfering field strength on the allotment of the other administration as mentioned in the Agreement 0.5 dB higher than the maximum between :
 - a. The cumulative field strength of all the assignments defined in this Agreement as implementing the allotment
 - b. The field strength of the allotment if mentioned in the agreement and otherwise the cumulative field strength of the reference network of the allotment
7. That for situations where the term "excluding" is mentioned in the conditions imposed, the conditions for both the allotment and the assignments have to be fulfilled independently.
8. That the power sum methodology will be used to calculate the cumulative field strength.
9. Where there is a difference between the technical parameters described in the Annex 2 and the conditions in Annex 1, the conditions described in Annex 1 have priority.
10. Where the coordination agreements necessary for the successful completion of the corresponding GE-06 Plan modification have not been obtained, both parties agree to cooperate to identify and implement mutually satisfactory solutions.


